Instructional Strategies-Activities	<p>Students will read the excerpt about the Establishment of Mitchelville from the 2014 SC African American Calendar.</p> <p>The teacher will facilitate a discussion on national anthems from the United States and Canada.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -What is the importance of a national anthem? -What is the subject matter of these anthems? -How do these anthems instill pride in their nation? <p>Many national anthems are sung to the tune of notable hymns and common</p>

regional tunes.

The teacher will play the national anthems of the United States and Canada.

Working with a partner, students will create lyrics to an anthem in recognition of Mitchelville.

-Anthems must include historical events that happened during the development and establishment of Mitchelville.

Students will perform their anthems for their classmates using a hymn or common tune of their choice.
