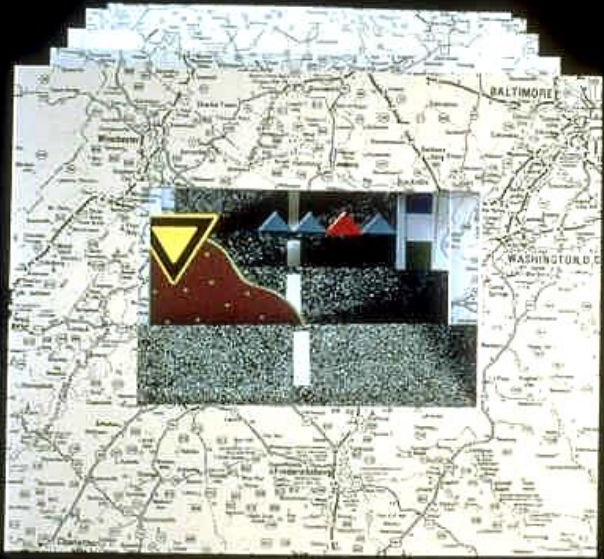
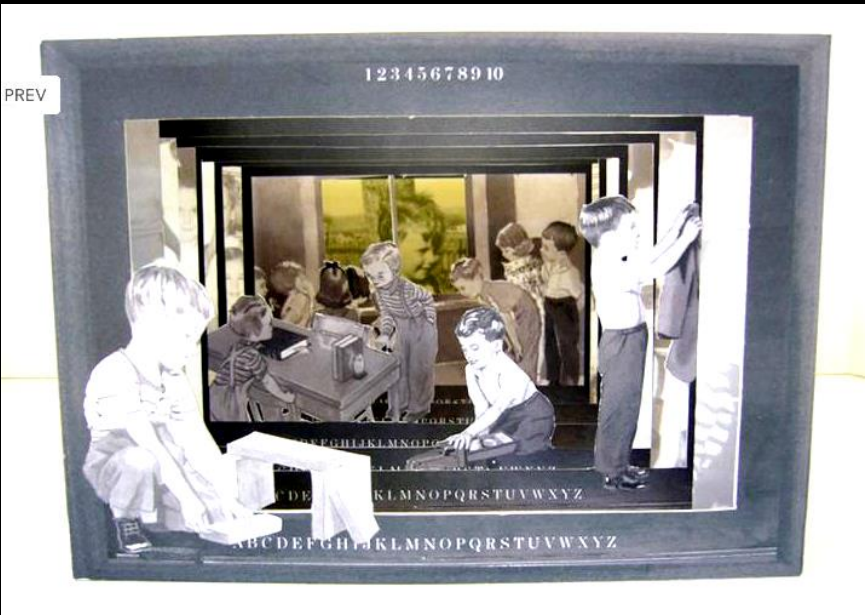

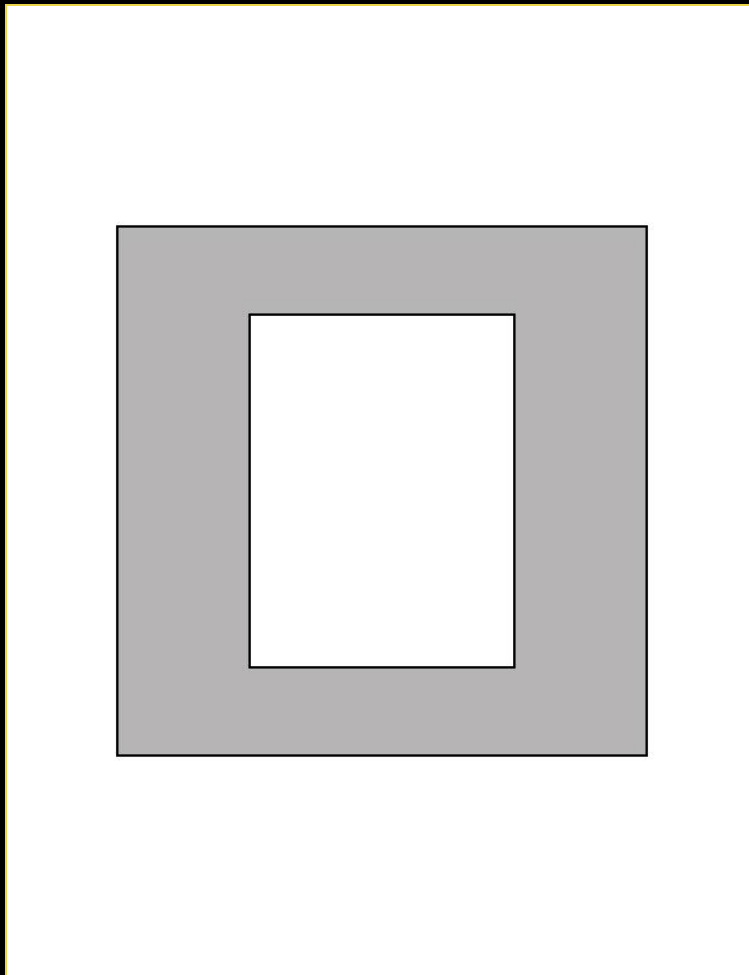

Step-by-Step: Tunnel Book



1. Download Tunnel Book Template for Photoshop Elements



2. Create Tunnel Book Design using Template in Photoshop Elements

Step-by-Step: Tunnel Book

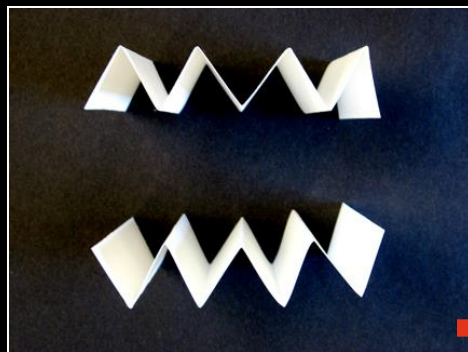
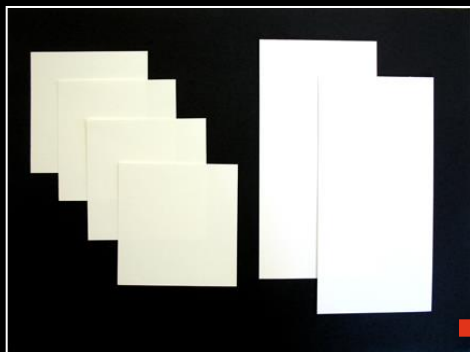


3. Print Tunnel Book Files in Separate Layers: Foreground, Middlegrounds, Background.

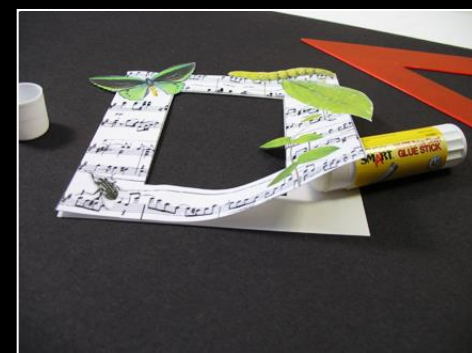
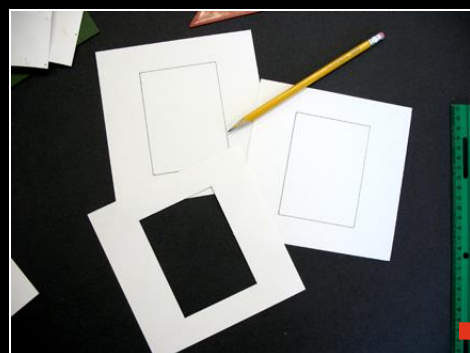


4. Create Tunnel Book with Tag Board, Glue, Xacto Knife, Printed Files, Craftsmanship, Imagination and Instructions.

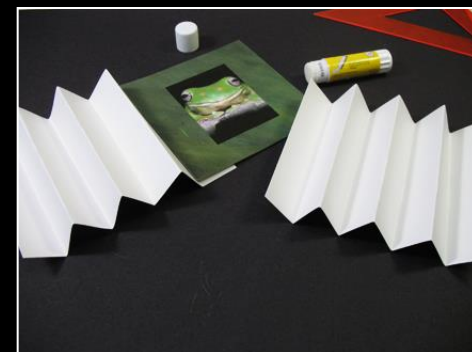
Step-by-Step: Materials and Assembly for Tunnel Book



Fold accordion panels and make 2-to-4 window panels for front cover and middle sections



Print and cut Photoshop file imagery and begin gluing imagery to panels



Finish gluing all panels and then begin assembling book

Step-by-Step: Materials and Assembly for Tunnel Book

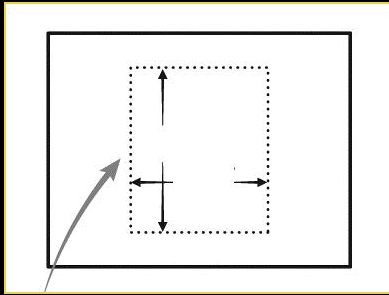


Assemble back panel first to support tunnel book sides



Begin inserting window panels building toward front cover: construct back to front

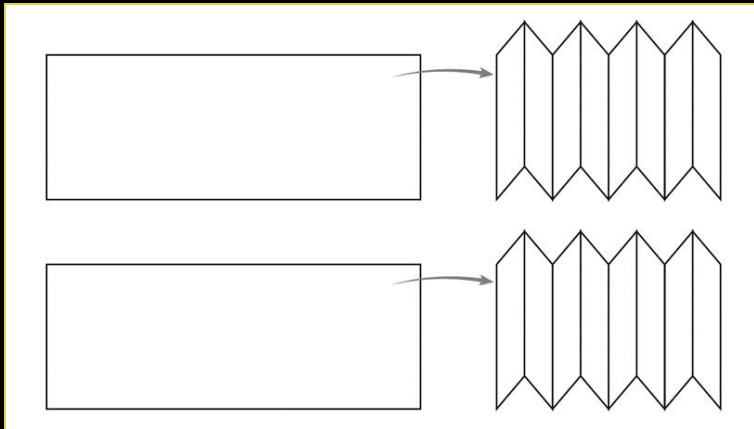
Step-by-Step: Materials and Assembly for Tunnel Book



You will need
**2-to-4 window
panels for front
cover and
middle-ground
sections**



You will need
**1 solid panel for
background**



To assemble the book:

Glue the back cover to the accordion sides. Attach it to the front side of the last fold on each accordion side.

Back view

Glue cut-paper shape to the front sides of the accordion folds.

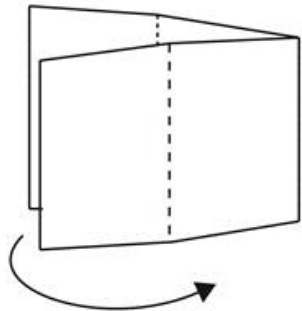
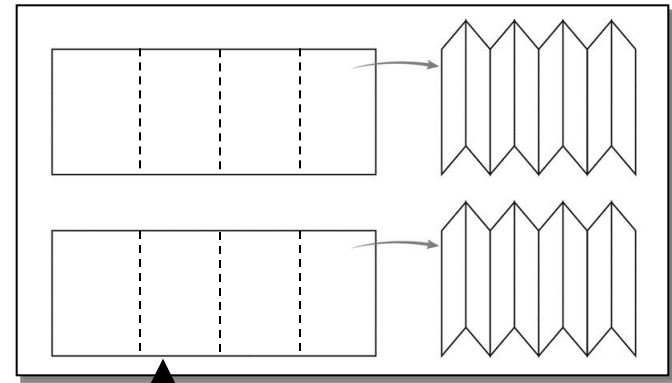
Glue the front cover to the accordion sides.

Attach it to the outside of the first fold on each accordion side.

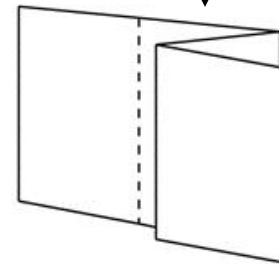
Precut paper: You will need to create 2 identical accordion fold panels for the side structures of the Tunnel Book

Step-by-Step: Making an Accordion Fold

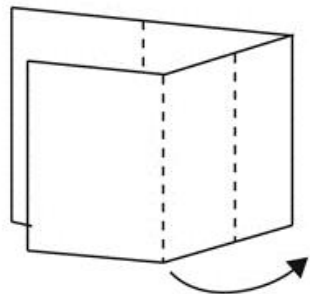
Carefully follow instructions:
this is not like folding a fan!



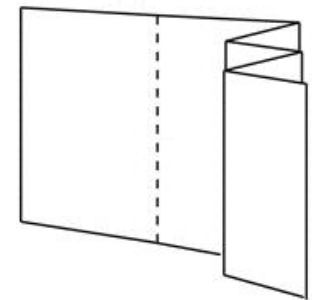
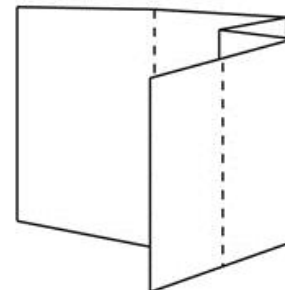
A.
Fold sheet of
6" x 12" pre-cut
paper in half.
Take one end and
fold it back to the
center fold:



B.
Do this to both
sides so that
you have 3 folds
and 4 sections



C.
Take one section
and fold it in half
again, back to the
centerfold, and
then repeat for
each section



Step-by-Step Design: Preparing Imagery/Photoshop Files

- 1) **Be organized: create project folder**> Your Name + Tunnel Book
- 2) **Download template into your project folder. This is essential for formatting file and image sizes**
- 3) **Choose a Theme: nature, animals, space, art: visual or performing, sports, etc.**
- 4) **Brainstorm and research your ideas**
- 5) **Store all original photo sources in your project folder!**
- 6) **Use your Photoshop skills to alter your imagery. There must be evidence of: selection tools, cropping, filters, transforming size/proportion, altering color, contrast, etc.**
- 7) **You are encouraged to expand the format of the front cover of your tunnel book: you may use lesson examples for inspiration**
- 8) **You may use traditional art techniques to finish approximately 25% of your design - this is optional**
- 9) **Attention to details and craftsmanship are essential to your success**
